H.1 AUTHORITIES

The tables that follow list the major federal and state laws, county ordinances, and Executive Orders that establish permits, approvals, or consultations that may apply to the siting, construction, operation, and decommissioning of solar energy and transmission line projects on U.S. Department of the Interior (DOI) Bureau of Land Management (BLM) lands. The general application of these authorities and other regulatory considerations associated with such siting, construction, operation, and decommissioning are discussed in Chapter 3.

Tables H-1 through H-15 are divided into general environmental impact categories. The citations in the tables are those of the general authorities that govern the category. Under such authority, the lead federal or state agency may have promulgated implementing regulations that set forth detailed procedures for permitting and compliance. County zoning or land use ordinances may also contain specific requirements related to these impact categories.

The use of “NA” in the tables indicates that no specifically applicable ordinance was located.
