I have concerns for the negative effect on Wildlife and the reduction of recreational lands within Clark County. This is land is currently multiple use and is compatible with everything from hunting to OHV racing. Reduction of this large amount of multiple use recreational land so nearby to a large population center like Las Vegas would result in additional pressure on more sensitive lands within the Multiple Species Habitat Conservation Plan. The lost of this large amount of acreage appears contrary the required maintenance of Multiple Use Management Areas (MUMAs) to provide conservation value as corridors, connections and buffers for the Intensively Managed Areas (IMAs) and Less Intensively Managed Areas (LIMAs).
