I wish to oppose the plan to install solar energy collectors at the Knight Ranch road site near Jean, Nevada.

While I am strongly in favor of producing more power from alternative energy sources, and have even owned a home with solar, and wind generated power, I feel this site is inappropriate. OHV users have steadily been pushed out of the Las Vegas valley over the last decade, and one of the few remaining areas available to these users is the Jean dry lake bed and it's surroundings.
